



PEAK Admission Testing Information

The Cognitive Ability screening scores which will be considered by the PEAK Selection Committee will consist of CogAT and NNAT scores for most applicants. You may provide the test results you already have if they are no more than 3 years old (taken no later than the student's fifth grade year). We will accept comparable data which measures the equivalent of these tests, such as the WISC IV, DAS, Stanford- Binet, OLSAT, etc.

If the applicant does not have recent Cognitive Ability data, please schedule a testing time. Both the CogAT and the NNAT will be provided free of charge for any applicant requesting a testing time. Testing sessions will be arranged in October, November, and December for Round One applicants and also during the spring semester for Round Two applicants.

Please have your testing time arranged before the December 2nd application deadline (for Round One applicants) or before the April 21st application deadline (for Round Two applicants). (Note: Students applying after 12/2/2009 will be considered on a space-available basis and are more likely to be placed on a waiting list.)
