Information	Strategic Plan Overview: Presented by Dr Kim Equity with all schools including start times, and length of school days. Teachers need to be resourced, be in collaboration with other teachers and colleagues. Schools will have the same curriculum throughout the district. Every student graduate with the knowledge and skills of post-secondary life.  Students will all read on grade level by 3rd grade. High dosage tutoring will be used to assist students with reading and math. ICAP helps students and staff identify what they would like to do after graduation.  This spring the district will look at bringing together community, business, and education individuals to address preparing our high schoolers for their future.
