It is important to note that the reported data is based on students' addresses, rather than the data collected in the school choice process, it is a representation of the student choice-in and choice-out data. Errors may occur due to multiple addresses for each student, center-based program placement, as well as other school choice variables. Jeffco Schools does not currently utilize an on-line or systemic process for capturing choice enrollment by household to populate a data base for analysis. Thus, as noted above, this data does not address the impact of multiple addresses associated with a student or district assigned programming (e.g., Fletcher Miller, or GT center, or a SPED center program is an assigned enrollment; however, such situations appear in this data as a "choice out" or "choice in" statistic).
