Our Mission & Vision

Our mission is to provide a quality education that prepares all children for a successful future. In October 2017 the district rolled out **Jeffco Generations: A Learning-Centered Vision for our Community's Schools**. The document is the focal point for district strategic planning, goal setting, and both staff and Board of Education decisions.

The vision focus areas are Learning, Conditions for Learning, and Readiness for Learning. There are seven Jeffco Generations skills, building on the previous vision (Jeffco 2020): Content Mastery, Civic & Global Engagement, Self-Direction & Personal Responsibility, Communication, Critical & Creative Thinking, Collaboration & Leading by Influence, Agility & Adaptability.

Our Schools

- Jeffco has 156 schools on 168 campuses:
 - 87 elementary schools
 - 5 K-8 schools
 - 17 middle schools
 - 17 high schools
 - 9 option schools
 - 18 charter schools
 - 1 online school
 - 2 outdoor laboratory schools
- 2016 National Blue Ribbon School - Deviny Elementary
- 2017 National Blue Ribbon School - Dennison Elementary
- U.S. News & World Report ranked 11 Jeffco high schools in the top 50 in Colorado on their 2017 Best High Schools list.
- Next school year, many of our 6th-graders will transition to middle schools, offering those students more educational opportunities, utilizing middle schools more effectively, and drastically reducing the number of temporary classrooms now in use at elementary schools.
- We are the second largest K-12 school district in Colorado with a tradition of excellence spanning more than 65 years.

Our Students

- Jeffco students consistently outperform the state of Colorado average score on CMAS and PARCC assessments.
- Jeffco's high school on-time graduation rate is 90.7%; the district on-time graduation rate (including option, alternative and charter schools) is 83.7%.
- Jeffco graduates earned more than \$80 million in scholarships to local and national colleges and universities and over 180 of our student athletes were signed by college teams across the U.S. in 2017.
- Jeffco serves more than 86,000 students who come from many different experiences and backgrounds:
 - American Indian/Alaska Native..... 1%
 - Asian, Pacific Islander 3%
 - Black 1%
 - Hispanic 25%
 - White 67%
 - Multiple Races 3%
- Almost one-third of our students qualify for free and reduced lunch.

Our Staff

- Jeffco has approximately 5,300 licensed educators and many have received national and state recognition for their work.
- We are the largest employer in Jefferson County with more than 14,000 full and part-time employees.
- Our organizational values are: Integrity, Valuing People, Teamwork, Exemplary Performance, and Entrepreneurial Spirit.

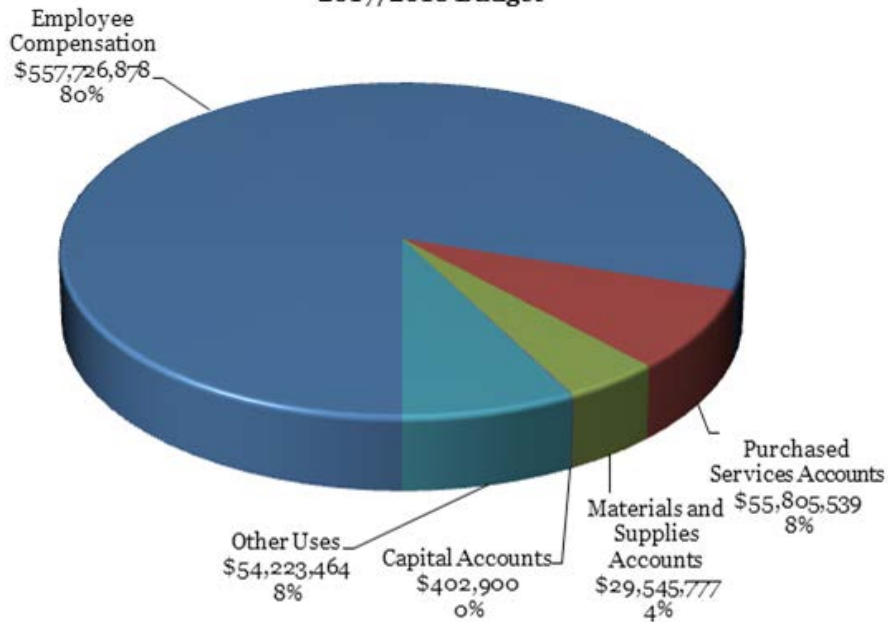

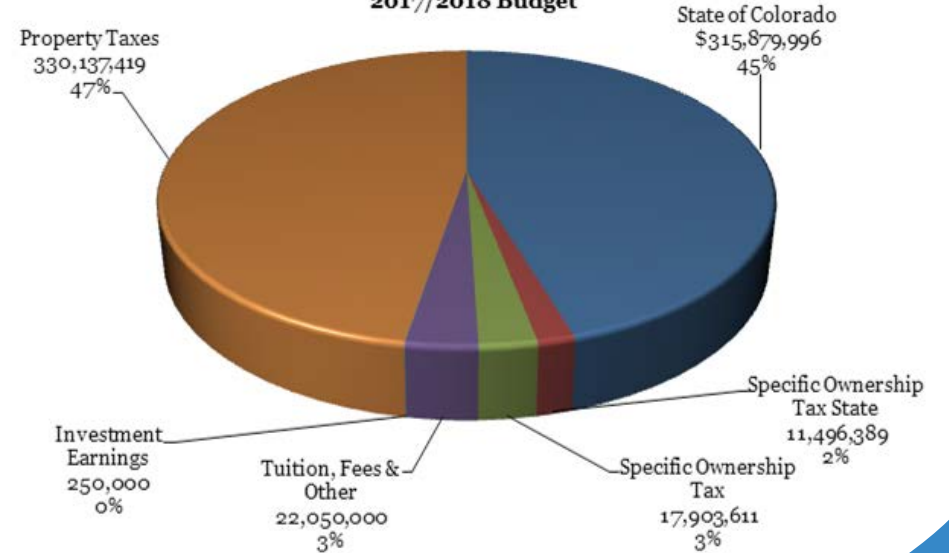
Our Budget
