TRAILBLAZER STADIUM

Location of Field: 100 Kipling. From I-25, go west on 6th Avenue to Kipling, south. The stadium is located seven blocks south of Kipling and 6th Avenue.

Visitor's Team Bench: West side.

Programs: Programs are published by the home school.

Head Sets: Two phones are available in each press box and on the sidelines. The visiting team phones are in the east booth, south end. Field phone system has capability of splitting offense and defense. Splitting switch is located in spotter's booth.

Press Box: Available space is limited.

Media Coverage: Limited cable or radio coverage – clear this through Ezra Paddock, 720-331-7289.

Buses: Team buses park on north side of stadium. Student buses, band buses and spectator buses park along east side of stadium.

Playing Field: Trailblazer Stadium has an artificial turf field.

Visitor Seating: West side of the stadium (500 grandstand seats only). From main entrance to stadium, turn left to access north end of parking lot. Enter stadium at the northeast ticket gate.

Team Dressing: North side. Visitors – West end dressing room. Home – East end dressing room.

Teams traveling long distances who change after arrival need to make special arrangements with the home team athletics director. Teams need to bring towels if they plan to shower (in an alternate location).

Team Warm-up: Visitors – north end of field. Home - south end of field.

National Anthem and Coin Flip: The coin flip will take place five (5) minutes prior to game time. The National Anthem will be played three (3) minutes prior to game time and we request that all players and football personnel stand in front of their designated benches.

Team Colors: Home – Dark; Visitor – White

Game Video: Jefferson County films all home contests in HUDL. Film will be shared with home team.

Scouting: Upcoming opponents' football scouts to Jeffco games will be admitted with a League I.D. No seating is available in the press box. Please enter through the southeast gate.

Ambulance: Ambulance service is within five (5) minutes of the facility. Expenses incurred for use will be the responsibility of the requesting school or party.

Tickets and Passes: Arrangements for accepting league passes other than Jeffco will be made prior to the start of the season. Only CHSAA passes are accepted for playoffs. Regular season ticket prices are as follows and are payable in cash or credit card.

Adults \$6.00; Jeffco High & Middle School Students with an Activity Pass are free; Ages 7-12, seniors, & students without Activity Pass \$4.00; Age 6 & Under Free. Jefferson County Athletics department has a no re-entry policy during the course of the game. Cash and credit cards are accepted.

Tobacco Free: The use of tobacco by students, teachers, staff and visitors in or on any school property, or at any student activity sponsored by the school district, is prohibited.

Alcohol & Marijuana- Use or possession of marijuana or alcohol is NOT permitted on any Jeffco property, including stadiums. Spectators are not allowed to bring outside food or beverages into Jeffco stadiums. This includes but is not limited to water bottles and carbonated beverages in cans or bottles.

Backpacks are not permitted in the stadiums, and carry bags are subject to search upon stadium entry.

Noisemakers: Sports specific CHSAA guidelines on noisemakers will be followed throughout the season.

Banners: A school's official banner may be displayed. (Avoid using duct tape because it removes paint from railings.) Solicitation is not allowed on the premises.

Animals: Service animals are permitted. No pets are allowed.
